

Long-Term Care Insurance is a System Supported by All of Society that Provides Nursing Care for the Elderly

Under this system, the Osaka City Government is the insurer while all residents age 40 and older are insured individuals who pay premiums. If you become in need of care or support, or have received Care (Support) Need Certification, you will be eligible to receive care services by paying the user fees.

The Elderly Health and Welfare Plan, The Long-Term Care Insurance Plan

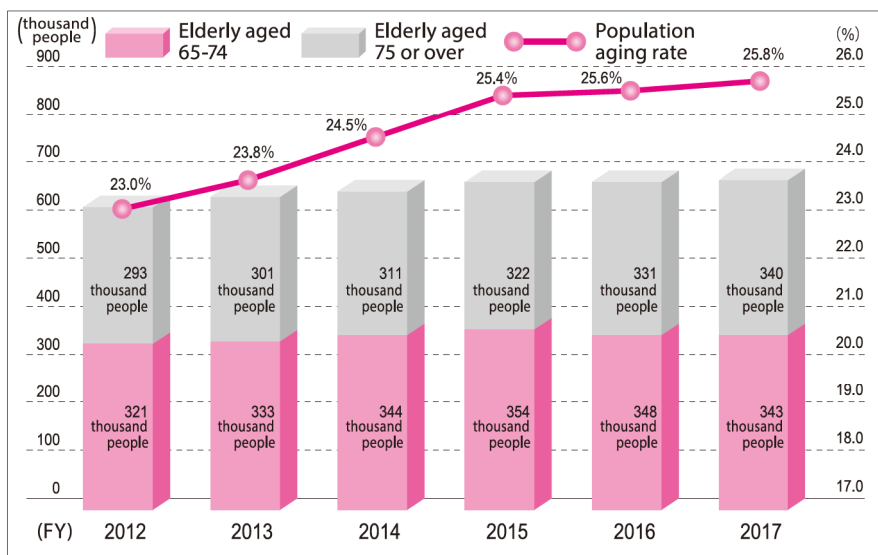
A basic 3-year plan (FY 2015-2017) is in place to ensure policies concerning the elderly are carried out in Osaka City.

- (4) Providing user-friendly services

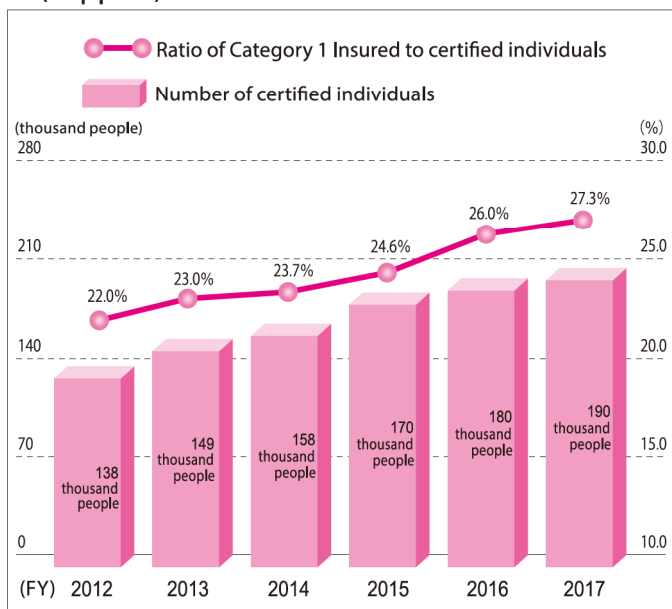
Current Situation of Aging in Osaka City and Estimates for Expenditure

1. Estimated Elderly Population (Category 1 Insured)

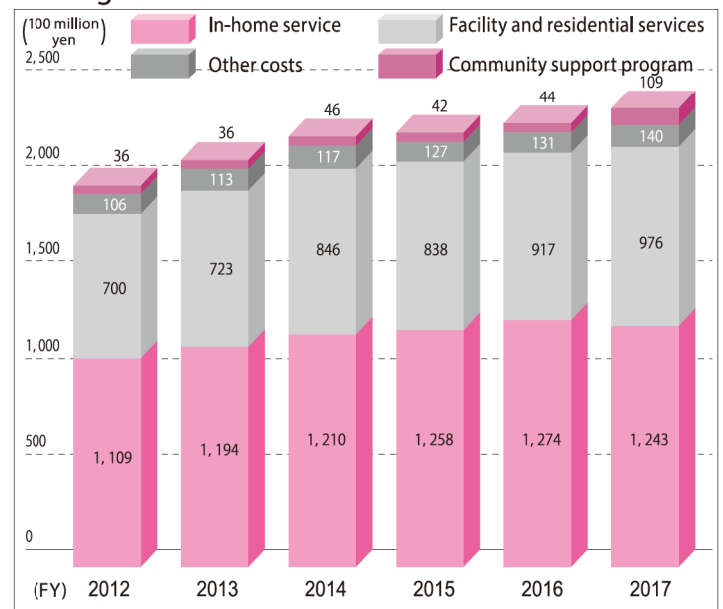


Note: Charts 1, 2 and 3 give actual numbers for FY2012 and FY2013 while figures for FY2014 and afterward are estimates.
