

In-Home Care Service Providers

Provide consultations for care service recipients to create personalized **care plans** while taking their requests and health conditions into consideration. They also act as intermediary contacts with the municipality and other relevant service providers.

Preventive Care Service Providers (Local Comprehensive Support Centers)

Conduct general consultations and rights advocacy, support for care managers, and preventive long-term care management (see below). Additionally, they act as preventive care service providers by creating **care plans** for those classified as requiring Support Levels 1 and 2 so as to help them lead independent lives. They also act as intermediary contacts with relevant service providers.

Local Comprehensive Support Centers

Provide consultations for the elderly, their families, and care managers (care service specialists) in addition to preparing care plans for those classified as requiring Support Levels 1 and 2.
