Review on user cost (from August 2015)

In order to enhance the sustainability of the system while suppressing the insurance premiums increase as low as possible, the user cost, which has been 10% across the board, will be 20% for those who possess certain income starting from August 2015.

"Long-Term Care Insurance Cost Ratio Certificate" which describes the cost ratio (10% or 20%) will be delivered to all of the insured who are qualified as support need and care need.
