(Support Level 1 and 2)

- For preventive care purposes, assistance with daily activities and rehabilitation services are available.
- In addition, the select services listed below can be added.
- 1. Motor function improvement*

To prevent and improve deterioration in motor function due to aging, exercise is done under the advice of a physical therapist.

- *Motor functions depend on the musculoskeletal system such as the bones, joints, muscles, and nerves.
- 2. Improvement of nutrition

To prevent malnutrition, consult with a nationally registered dietitian for advice on meals and nutritional management.

- 3. Improvement of oral function
 - A dental hygienist gives instructions on swallowing and mouth cleaning.
- For day service users, the group activities explained below are available. If you use 4 together with one of 1 to 3, you do not have to pay for 4.
- 4. Group activities for improving ability to carry out daily life activities For the purpose of improving care recipients' ability to carry out activities of daily living, necessary support in daily activities is offered. These services are addressed to a care recipients' group which share common difficulties in their daily lives.
