
Other In-Home Care Services for the Elderly

1. Emergency Alert System

The City of Osaka loans emergency alert devices and pendant-type switches to those who are ages 65 and older living alone, or left alone for eight hours or more a day because other family members are working, or the household consists of only elderly residents. In case of emergency, the Response Center accepts 24-hour emergency alerts of sudden illness. If an emergency alert has been sent or if there is no response from the elderly resident, the center immediately calls for an ambulance to be dispatched. The City also provides consultations regarding health problems in daily life.

Note: In some cases, the user will be charged.

2. Provision of Daily Living Equipment

Daily living equipment is provided to the housebound elderly for their convenience.

Eligible persons: Housebound individuals ages 65 and over who do not have proper equipment in the home and who fulfill all conditions.

Note: Limitations due to income level may apply. In some cases, the user may be charged.

3. Provision of Nursing Supplies

Nursing supplies are provided to the families taking care of housebound elderly who are Care Level 4 or 5, or Care Level 3 and need full assistance with urination or defecation.

Note: Limited to households with elderly persons requiring care and caretaker households, either of which must be exempt from municipal tax.

A redeemable voucher for nursing supplies is provided upon application starting in the month of approval. (Maximum of 12 vouchers per year)

4. Home Renovation Subsidy Program for Senior Citizens

When using nursing care insurance to make a home renovation for those with Care Need/Support Need Certification, a grant may be provided to cover construction costs (up to 300,000 yen) that are not covered by the insurance. The amount of the benefit depends on the household income and part of the costs must be borne by the user.

5. Meal Service

Balanced meals are delivered to the elderly (with Care Need/Support Need Certification) living alone or households consisting of only elderly residents if they find it difficult to prepare meals due to mental and/or physical disorders. This service also includes checking up on the elderly.

6. Support Program for Family Caretakers

Seminars and meetings to learn about care techniques are held for those taking care of an elderly person requiring nursing care.

7. Service Reward Program for Family Caretakers

A service reward is paid to family members who took care of housebound elderly requiring care (Care Level 4 or 5) over the last year or more without using nursing care insurance services. The program is also aimed at promoting use of the nursing care insurance system. (It is required that none of the members of the household to which the caregiver and care-receiver belong are not imposed of the municipal tax.)

Service reward: 100,000 yen for one year
