

What is a neighborhood association?

The neighborhood association is a voluntary organization based on connections between people living in the area, and is the core organization of the various organizations that make up the community activity council. In times of emergency, you can rely on the familiar faces of your immediate neighbors.

Join the neighborhood association and participate in the creation of "connections" and "bonds" that cooperate, support, and help each other, such as disaster prevention drills in preparation for initial response in the event of a major disaster, watching over the elderly and going to and from school, cleaning activities, and interacting at summer festivals, and creating a safe, secure, and livable community!

What does Community Activity Council mean?
