Quick and Easy to Do! Improving Crow Countermeasures

~Tips on preventing scattered garbage caused by crows~ 🚜

- Let's reduce kitchen waste and leftovers, which are food sources that crows thrive on.
- 2 Use items such as nets to cut off crows' access to garbage.
- 3 Before putting out garbage, make sure things such as kitchen waste are not visible.
 - Hide kitchen waste by wrapping it with materials like newspapers and paper bags, and then put it out.
- To limit the amount of time that crows have for targeting food, please do not put out your garbage the night before.

 Try to put out garbage right before the collection time.
- Let's carry out efforts together as a community!

 To reduce damages caused by crows, it is important for everyone in the community to work together and further spread crow countermeasures. We kindly request for your cooperation.

Crows are clever creatures with high cognitive abilities. Let's properly use nets to prevent damages caused by crows. To cover all of the disposed

garbage, make sure the edges of the net are tucked under the garbage.


If the edges of the net are not properly tucked under the garbage, crows can penetrate through by lifting up the net through openings.

We lend out crow nets free of charge.

To prevent cases of scattered garbage by crows, the City of Osaka lends out crow (anti-bird) nets for free to designated garbage disposal/collection sites (generally used by 5 households or more).
