For business-related garbage, let's correctly separate it.

Osaka City's Garbage Situation



About 60% of Osaka City's disposed garbage accounts for **business-related garbage**, which is a lot more compared to other cities. With the aim to reduce garbage, it is important to **correctly separate it**.

In order to reduce garbage, it is essential to have the cooperation of business operators!
From here on, we will explain about the correct garbage disposal method.

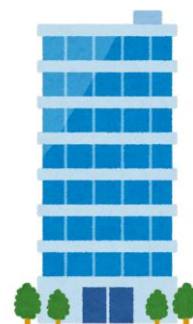
The business operator is **solely responsible** for **fulfilling the obligation to properly dispose of garbage** generated from business activities.

The separation method is wrong !

Household-related Garbage



Business-related Garbage



Garbage disposed by a business site is actually "**business-related garbage**" and not household-related garbage. Separation method will be conducted in accordance with the Waste Disposal Act. An outsourced licensed contractor will carry out collection, transportation, and disposal tasks. Under the **responsibility of the business operator**, garbage will be **properly disposed**.

POINT②



Let's **correctly separate** business-related garbage into "business-related general waste" and "industrial waste", and then **properly dispose** of it.

For business-related garbage that has been separated, **the business operator can bring it directly to the treatment facility or outsource licensed contractor** to dispose of it.

In addition, **it is prohibited to bring "recyclable paper" to the incineration plant!**



Business-Related General Waste

Recyclable Paper

<Examples>
Newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes, paper packs, shredded paper, etc.

Non-Recyclable Paper; Kitchen Garbage

<Examples>
Paper with smell (paper box of detergent, etc.), Paper that cannot be dissolved in water (paper cup, etc.), Leftovers, etc.

Outsource Recycling Business Operator

Recycling Facility



Outsource licensed contractor (*1) or Bring it yourself

Incineration Plant (*2)



*1 A licensed contractor who can collect and transport general waste.

*2 For recyclable paper and industrial waste, **it is prohibited to bring them to an incineration plant.**

Industrial Waste

Plastics

<Examples>
Plastic bottles, styrofoam, plastic snack bags, cup noodle containers, etc.

Glass & Ceramics

<Examples>
Glass bottles, ceramics, etc.

Metals

<Examples>
Cans, metal products, etc.

Outsource licensed contractor (*3) or Bring it yourself

Industrial Waste Treatment Facility



Recycling Facility



Or

*3 A licensed contractor who can manage industrial waste treatment (collection, transportation, and disposal). It is necessary to establish a **written contract** for outsourcing.
