Collectible small rechargeable batteries are marked with a recycling symbol. (In some cases, such as with imported products, this mark may not be displayed. There is no marking on mobile batteries.)
We also accept swollen and deformed batteries.
 Please insulate the metal terminals and lead wires with vinyl tape.
 Items that cannot be removed from the main unit, such as wireless earphones, will be collected as they are.
 If you use the door-to-door collection service, please place the batteries in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.
