

# Items That Osaka City Does Not Collect

(Consult stores that handle the items, or the manufacturers.)

Do not bring dangerous items or items that are hard to dispose of because such items may cause fire accidents in waste collection cars, injury accidents to workers, breakdown of waste disposal facilities, or other accidents.  
Moreover, Osaka City cannot collect items designated in the Act on Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances. (See page 2.)

## Dangerous items and items hard to dispose of

- Harmful chemicals ● Gas cylinders ● Fire extinguishers
- Car batteries ● Gasoline ● Kerosene ● Thinner ● Waste oil
- Motorcycles ● Minibikes ● Strongboxes (excluding portable cashboxes) ● Pianos ● Car tires ● Paint, etc.
- Others ● Button cell batteries ● Small rechargeable dry cell batteries

## Items designated in the Act on Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances

- Air conditioners ● TVs
- Refrigerators and freezers
- Washing machines and clothes dryers

## Regarding stoppage of waste collection during typhoons, etc. and strong winds

In the event of a typhoon, there are numerous risks involved in the disposal and collection of waste in Osaka City, and collection stoppages may occur.

If you are in an area where collection has stopped and retrieval of waste is impossible, please dispose of it on the **next waste collection day**.

(Conditions for stoppages)

If by 6:00 a.m. on the day of the collection the Japan Meteorological Agency has issued a forecast for strong winds averaging over 30 meters per second in Osaka City, waste collection will be stopped as per the following.

Time period forecast for strong winds	From 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.	From 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Work stoppage	Whole day	Work will stop at 12:00 p.m.

## Bringing waste to the incineration plant by yourself

If you intend to dispose of waste by yourself, you can contact the incineration plant by phone and bring the waste there by yourself for a charge. Please note that you can bring up to one truckload of waste. (Use a 4-t or smaller truck.) Contact the incineration plant (see below) in charge of your area beforehand to arrange the date when you will bring the waste.

\* Appointment times: 9:00-12:00; 13:00-17:00 (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays and New Year)  
\* Waste acceptance times: 9:00-11:00; 13:00-15:00 (excluding Mondays, Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays and New Year)

\*Waste items that exceed one meter along the longest side and other larger waste items need to be crushed, etc. If you intend to bring such items by yourself, contact the Maishima Plant (tel.: 06-6463-4153) irrespective of your ward.

## Acceptance of the dead bodies of pets, such as dogs and cats

Contact the Environment Management Centers in charge of your area. The dead bodies of pet animals are accepted for a charge. Moreover, if you find the dead body of a dog, cat, etc. whose owner is unknown, on the road, contact the Environment Management Centers in charge of your area. In such a case, you will not be charged any fee. If you wish to have the body of your pet buried and/or hold a memorial service for your pet, request a private animal cemetery or the like for such service.

## Do not dump waste illegally!

Illegal dumping of waste is punished by law. Illegal dumping of waste is a criminal act, inconveniencing the local neighborhood and destroying the natural environment. If you find illegally dumped waste, contact the police or the Environment Management Centers in charge of the area.

## Disposal of injection needles from home medical care

Return injection needles or infectious waste related to home medical care to the medical institution. Do not dispose of such items as waste.
