

Dotombori River is a canal that was completed in 1615. At that time, the surrounding area was the scene of many playhouses, such as the Nakaza kabuki theater, and it flourished as a theater district.

### Kizu River [Length: 8.6 km]

Kizu River branches off from Tosabori River, and flows south to Osaka Bay. In the areas around Osaka Dome City, with the aim of creating a waterside culture reflecting the charm of Aquapolis Osaka, riverside spaces that blend the river with the surrounding town have been created and wide levees have been constructed to improve flood-control safety.
