Point at  (Relieved) and say "Please relax. It is safe here."

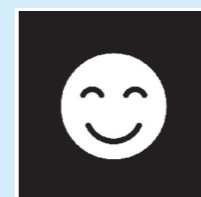

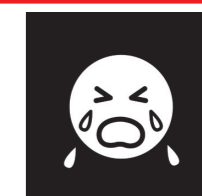
Show the pictogram on the right and ask "How painful is it?"
