

Types of Information and Responses

When a tsunami strikes

Osaka City issues an evacuation instruction (emergency) if a major tsunami warning or tsunami warning is issued. If you receive this information, evacuate swiftly.

Tsunami Information

If tsunami damage is expected after an earthquake, a major tsunami warning, tsunami warning, or tsunami advisory will be issued. Subsequently, information will be announced, such as estimated tsunami height and estimated tsunami arrival time.

1 m $20\text{cm} \leq \text{Height} \leq 1\text{m}$	N/A	Tsunami advisory	●Stay alert of tsunami information
