In addition to checking rain cloud radar and creating a checklist of stockpiles, in the event of a disaster, users can check information on the opening of evacuation centers, routes to evacuation centers, etc., and receive information from the Japan Meteorological Agency via push notifications.

If you send a blank email to "touroku@osaka-bousai.net" you will receive an email for registration / cancellation. If your phone has a code reader, scan the QR code and send an email.

Disaster Emergency Information

Emergency Earthquake Notifications

The Japan Meteorological Agency sends emergency earthquake notifications about earthquakes before strong tremors start. When an intensity of lower-5 or greater or long-period ground motion* of Class 3 or higher is forecast, within a few seconds to several tens of seconds before strong shaking arrives, areas where a seismic intensity of 4 or higher or long-period ground motion of Class 3 or higher will be alerted. There will be, for example, a superimposed warning information on a TV screen about the strong tremors, so always be ready to do what you need to do immediately to protect yourself.

Emergency Notification E-mails

In the event of an emergency, Osaka City simultaneously distributes emergency information such as evacuation advisories and directives to the mobile phones of people in the city using the emergency notification email services of each mobile phone company.

- No reception fees
- A specified tone alert rings and the information is displayed as a pop-up notification.
- Those who are in the city temporarily can also get the information.



* Depending on your model or type of mobile phone, you may not be able to receive the information or you may need to set it up for receipt.
