


Make an Emergency Map for Your Neighborhood

Walk around your neighborhood to look for dangerous spots, shelters, and evacuation areas (places like elementary and junior high schools, parks) and check on escape routes in case of emergency. It's a good idea to plan alternative routes in case a route is blocked for some reason. Then, draw an "Emergency Map of My Neighborhood" with simple illustrations.
