

## ② Take immediate action for personal safety

If you receive information about a missile launch, take immediate action to protect yourself.

If you are indoors



To avoid broken window glass, debris, etc.  
**Move away from windows or take shelter in a windowless room.**

If you are outdoors



To avoid blast, debris, etc.  
**Evacuate to a nearby building or underground.**



If there is no building nearby where you can take shelter



**Hide behind cover or lie on the ground to protect your head.**

In case you are riding a car

**Stop at a safe place and evacuate to a nearby building or underground as soon as possible.**



### Osaka City Initiatives

#### <Designation of Evacuation Facilities>

- ▶ Osaka City has been promoting the designation of evacuation facilities such as underground stations, underground shopping malls, and sturdy reinforced concrete buildings such as elementary and junior high schools.

- ▶ When evacuating in case of danger, please evacuate to a nearby building (preferably a sturdy building) or an underground facility, regardless of whether or not an evacuation facility has been designated.
