In Chuo Ward, inundation events due to flooding of the Yodo River and the Yamato River, flooding in the Neyagawa River basin (Neyagawa River, Second Neyagawa River, Hirano River, diversion aqueducts of Hirano River, and Furukawa River), a storm surge, and inland flooding and tsunami inundation events due to a massive Nankai Trough earthquake are assumed to occur.

If evacuation shelters are located far from your house, you should expect that it will take time for the elderly to

It is also important to secure more than one temporary shelter other than predesignated evacuation centers, such as securing condominium or other high buildings in the neighborhood by negotiating

Moreover, since it is dangerous to move out of your house during stormy weather, remaining in your house can be an alternative to evacuation as long as you have made appropriate disaster
