

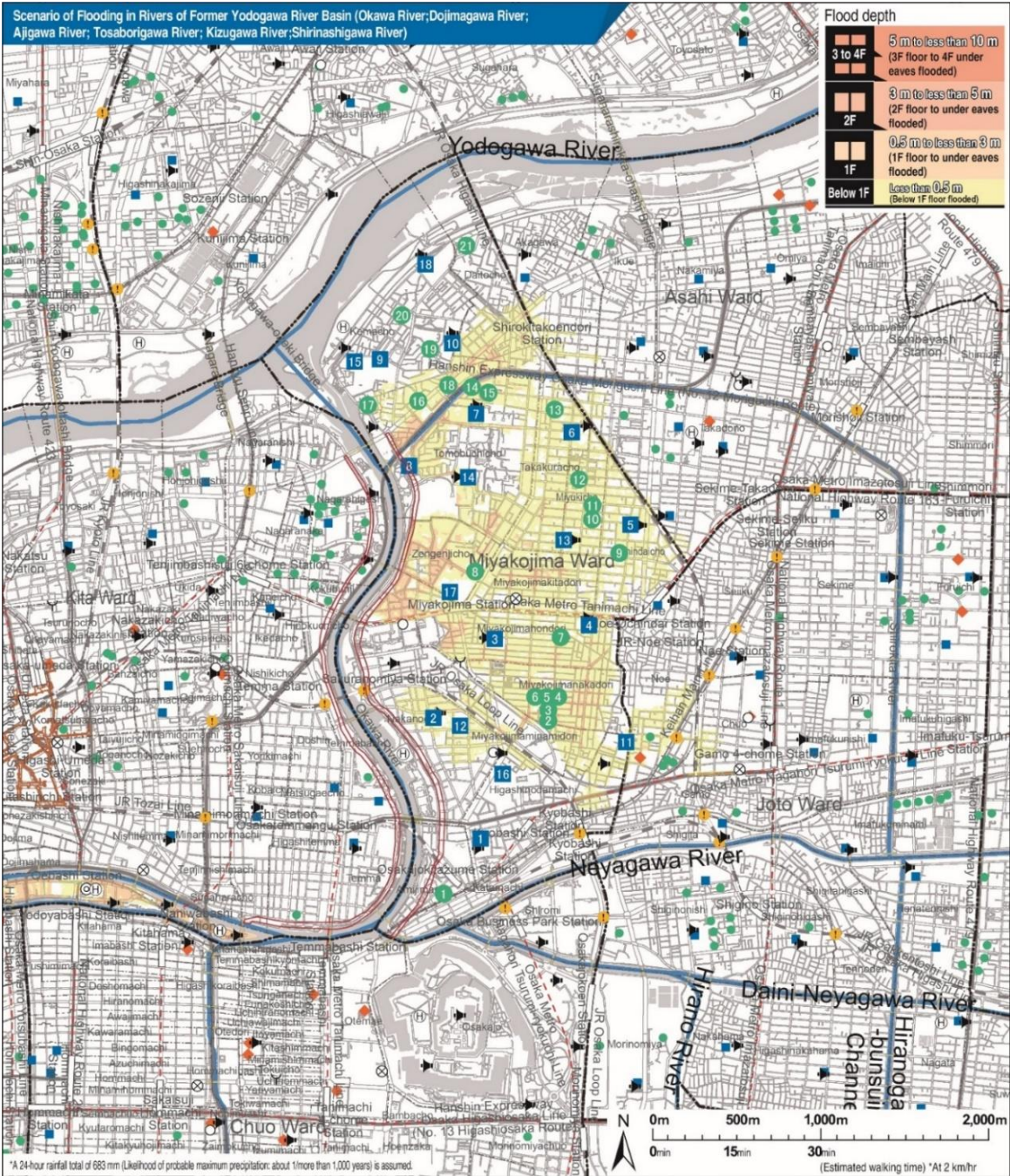
Additional Content for “Flood Disaster Prevention Map” (March 2021 Version)

The Osaka Prefectural Government announced the new flood risk zones on February 2022. The diagram below will be added on to the Flood Disaster Prevention Map (March 2021 Version).

※In the situation when “Storm Surge Warning in Osaka City Area” is announced, (Kizugawa Sluice Gate, Ajigawa Sluice Gate, and Shirinashigawa Sluice Gate are closed) the projected occurrence of record-breaking rainfalls can induce possible dangers of flooding.

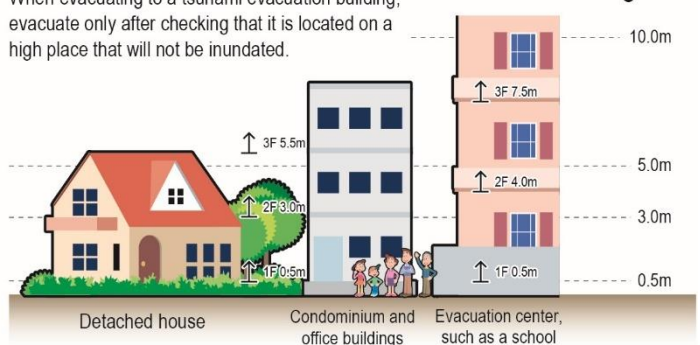
