During the Noto Peninsula Earthquake, many homes were destroyed.

Everyone always met up and knew each other well. By sharing this bond, the Noto residents were able to assist one another as they stayed in evacuation shelters (places where residents escape to during earthquakes and typhoons).

(Feel safe by joining your neighborhood association.)

Become acquainted with the people who live near you. Everyone can help each other during earthquakes, tsunamis, and typhoons.

Crime Prevention (Efforts for preventing crimes)

We carry out installation of security lights (to brighten dark roads) and security cameras (to prevent crimes).

Making Our Town Clean Cleaning up parks, etc. (We maintain the cleanliness of our communal spaces and nearby parks.)

There are neighborhood associations that collect fees (money paid by association members).
