Disaster Prevention

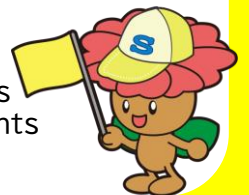
Workshops and safety drills are conducted to better prepare for disasters that can happen at any time.
