

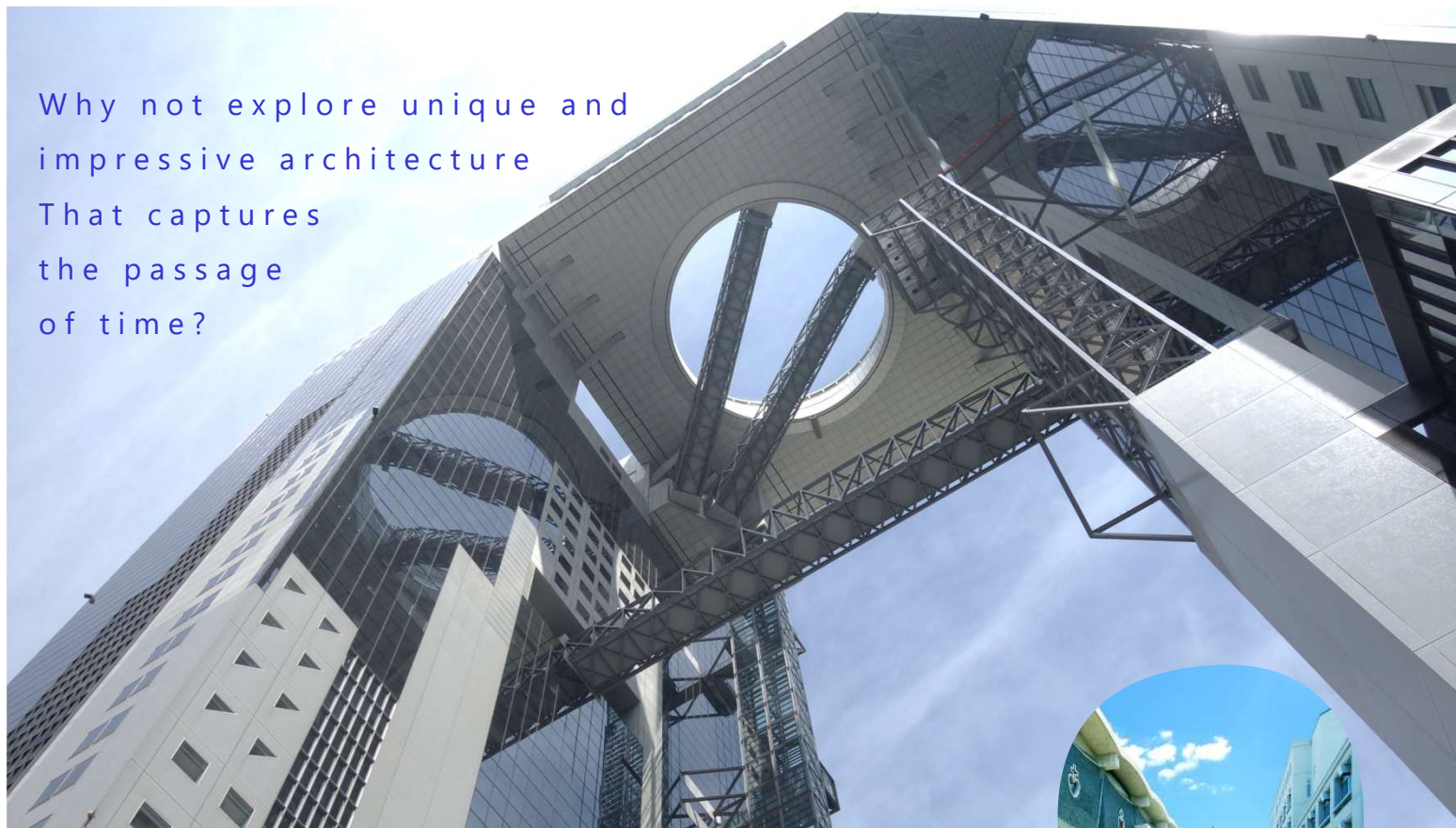
Osaka City's urban landscape resources Tour MAP

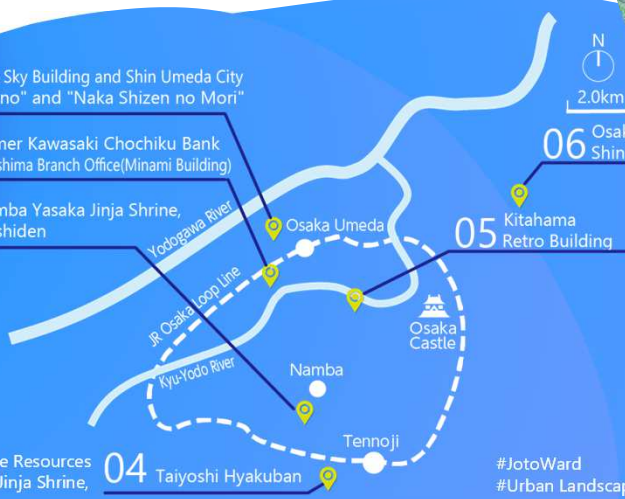
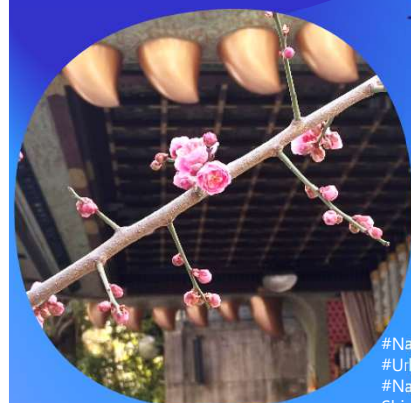

A landmark of Umeda, the Umeda Sky Building features a distinctive design that connects two towers 170 meters above ground. On the rooftop, the 360-degree Floating Garden Observatory offers stunning panoramic views. Surrounding the area, you can explore seasonal plants in beautifully maintained gardens like "Hanano" and "Chuu Shizen no Mori".

This historic building, a prime example of early Showa-era bank architecture, boasts a dignified facade. Its gently curved front is adorned with four Ionic columns while the eaves above the entrance are intricately carved, adding an elegant touch to the design.

The majestic lion stage at Namba Yasaka Jinja Shrine is a must-see attraction. Its powerful exterior captivates visitors, but the intricate carvings and detailed designs on the stage floor, walls, and ceiling are equally impressive. Worshippers from across Japan visit this iconic lion, believed to swallow evil spirits with its massive mouth and bring good fortune, particularly in business.

Located in downtown Osaka, this iconic building showcases Taisho-era architecture that boldly incorporated Western-style design elements. Today, it continues to operate as a Japanese-style restaurant, attracting countless visitors with its unique charm and historical significance.

Built around 100 years ago, this elegant structure resembles a European mansion, reflecting the vibrant spirit of Osaka during its era of construction. Now serving as a charming café, its north-facing second-floor windows offer picturesque views of the rose garden in Nakanoshima Park.
